To minimise contact:-

Holy Communion will be offered in one kind.

It is Anglican teaching that to receive the sacrament in one kind only (i.e. just the bread) is to receive the sacrament in its entirety. Only the priest will take the wine.

There will be **no shaking hands when sharing the Peace.** At Christ Church, we will remain where we are, make eye contact and smile with one another

There will be no physical contact as part of a blessing or saying of grace etc.

No refreshments will be served at any time.

The plate will not be taken round for collections. Plates will be left at the back of church for offerings

to be put there before or after the service.
